<u>CEMETERY:</u> Sexton Jeanne Chybik reviewed the report with the Board. Ms. Chybik also reviewed the Ride in Kane report.

SUPERVISOR: Distribution of 2023/24 Budget & Appropriation Ordinances: Supervisor Steel reviewed the Town B & A Ordinance and Highway Commissioner Rod Feece reviewed the Road District B & A Ordinance.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Supervisor Steel has been asked to mediate a meeting between Sugar Grove Village President Jen Konen and citizens of unincorporated Blackberry Township that would be affected by the Crown development.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Mr. Ray Fugiel thanked Highway Commissioner Rod Feece and his crew for tree trimming.
